

BATHING RULES

1. Persons, who suffer from contagious diseases (diarrhea, cold, sore throat, inflammation of the ear and/or eyes, skin inflammation etc.) are not to use the pool/whirlpool.
2. The pool/whirlpool are not to be used by persons, who suffer from incontinence.
3. Please shower before using the pool/whirlpool in the interest of hygiene.
4. Please shower after visiting the toilet.
5. If you have been perspiring or have used suntan oil/lotion, please shower before using the pool/whirlpool.
6. Swimming costumes must be clean and ought to be changed after using the pool/whirlpool. We recommend you shower afterwards, as this will reduce the risk of developing pseudomonas-folliculate (bacteria that causes boils in the outer ear and on the skin).
7. Inflatable toys/balls etc., which have been used outdoors, must be thoroughly cleaned prior to use in the pool area.
8. Outdoor footwear, sand from the sandpit etc. is strictly forbidden in the pool area.
9. Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
10. In order to safeguard the purification system in the pool, please make sure small objects/items i.e. swimming costumes, jewelry etc. is kept safely.
11. Avoid excessive use of the pool, as chlorine can give dry skin/ear infection – this will cause discomfort.
12. Should “accidents” occur with babies (urine/stools) please contact the owner of the house immediately, so the water can be cleaned.
13. Dont go for a swim in the pool when you are on your own.

It is important that the above rules are adhered to, as an unwashed person contaminates the water at least 200 times more than a washed person. If the rules are not obeyed, the service agent can close the pool and damages can be claimed. In order to give you and others a great experience, please help us to keep the pool area clean.
